

DDP Downtown Davenport SSMID Property & Business Owner Application Flood Relief Fund

As a result of the devastating 2019 flood, Downtown Davenport Partnership (DDP) allocated funds to assist downtown Davenport property and business owners directly impacted by flooding. Grant funding is available for downtown Davenport properties directly impacted by flooding for building repairs and capital improvements located within the Self-Supporting Municipal Improvement District (SSMID). Businesses are also eligible to apply if financing building improvements. Grants will be allocated from SSMID funds. The total amount available to each property will depend on how many properties apply and funds available, with an estimated maximum grant of \$10,000 per property. Downtown businesses located in the SSMID are also eligible to apply for the "Grow Quad Cities Business Relief" fund. DDP Board will oversee coordination, administration and distribution of funds.

Applications are due by July 3, 2019. Funding will be distributed by July 31, 2019

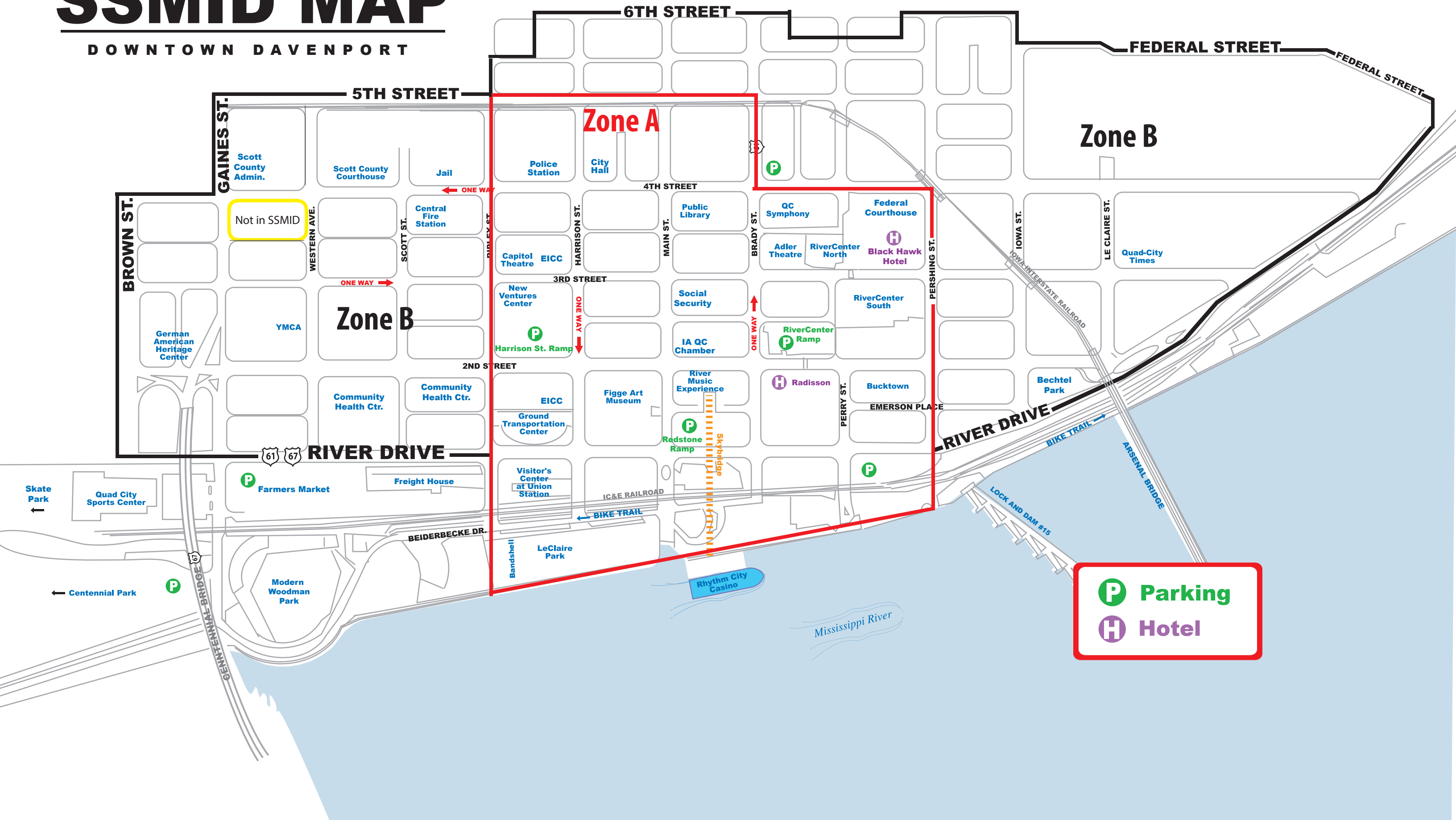
