

# Grow Quad Cities Business Relief Application Flood Recovery Fund

Grow Quad Cities Fund – Iowa (Grow Quad Cities) is a 501(c)(3) designated non-profit corporation that advances the general well-being and prosperity of Scott County and the surrounding region. As a result of the devastating 2019 flood, Grow Quad Cities has created a fund to assist local governments by supporting businesses directly impacted by flooding and related events. Funding is available for any business directly impacted by floodwater throughout Scott and Rock Island Counties. Funding from Grow Quad Cities can be utilized to cover losses (including equipment, product, revenue, and wages).

Grow Quad Cities has appointed Downtown Davenport Partnership (DDP), a division of the Quad Cities Chamber of Commerce, to assist in the coordination, administration and distribution of the funds. The total amount available to each business will depend on how many businesses apply and the funds available, with an estimated maximum grant of \$5,000.

**Applications are due by July 3, 2019. Funding will be distributed by July 31, 2019.**
